



## Assistant/Associate Professor of Biology

Tusculum University is seeking an Assistant/Associate Professor of Biology for Fall 2023 with an emphasis in zoology, with preference for wildlife biology and/or comparative anatomy. Position is available for an August 2023 start. This is a full-time, 10 month position. ### QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

A PhD degree in discipline is preferred; teaching experience with undergraduates is required. A Master's degree with at least 18 Masters level or higher credits in the discipline may be considered.
